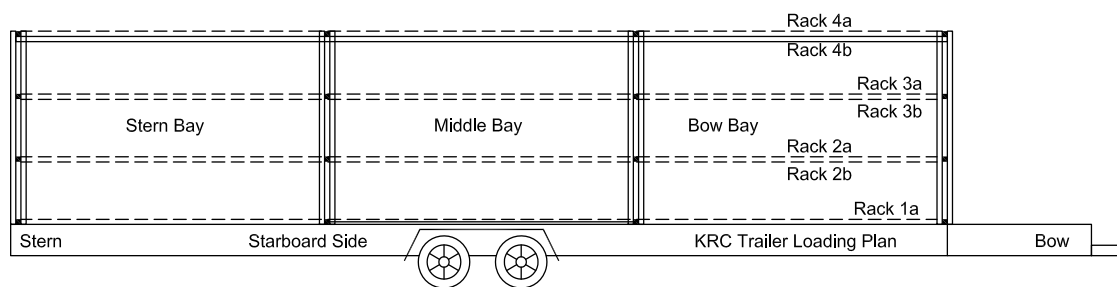
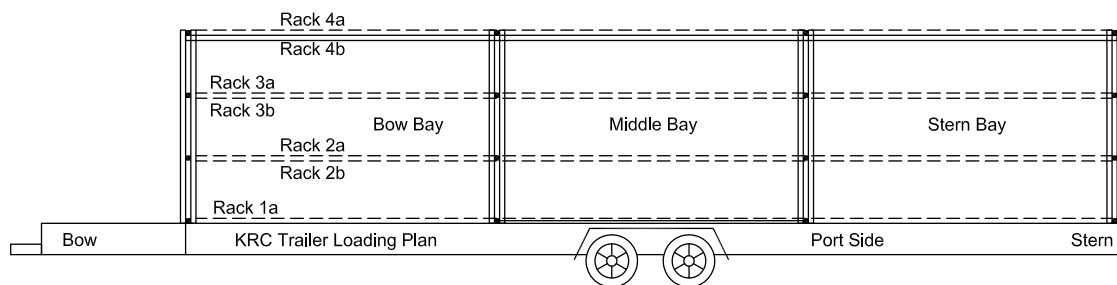


KENNEBECASIS ROWING CLUB TRAILER POLICY 2015-04-22

The Kennebecasis Rowing Club has, in 2015, purchased a boat trailer with funds generously donated by a sponsor. The trailer is a valuable and critically important

1. Except as otherwise stated herein, the Kennebecasis Rowing Club (“KRC”) boat trailer purchased in 2015 (the “Trailer”) shall be used solely by KRC members and solely for the purpose of representing KRC at regattas and other rowing events.
2. Any request for use of the Trailer by a person who is not a member of KRC (a “Request”) must be accompanied by a signed Trailer Use and Waiver Agreement in a form satisfactory to the KRC Board of Directors (the “Board”).
3. A Request shall be considered and determined by the Board. If the Board approves a Request, the Board shall require:
 - a) Payment in advance of a service fee in the amount of \$_____.
 - b) Mileage, fuel and other Trailer-related costs, to be assessed by the Board.
 - c) In cases where the Board agrees that KRC will share the Trailer with another person or organization (for example, Rothesay Netherwood School and the Fredericton Rowing Club), the Board or its designate shall, in its/their sole discretion, determine the order and manner of loading, unloading, operating, transporting and parking the Trailer.
4. No signage, logos, stickers, decals or flags shall be placed on the Trailer without the express permission of the Board.
5. It should be noted that the towing vehicle’s insurance policy is responsible for the trailer and contents.
